After scrutiny of the applications, eligible candidates will be informed the schedule of Brief Interactive Session &amp; Personal Interview (PI)</li> <li>2. <b>Brief Interactive Session</b> - Student will have an opportunity to interact with senior faculty/Director to clear their doubts regarding the program.</li> <li>3. <b>Personal Interview</b> - Experts will interview and assess the candidates on various parameters including the suitability of the candidates for offered specialisations.</li> <li>4. <b>Weightage</b> - Marks obtained in HSC/qualifying exam will carry 50% weightage and Personal Interview will carry 50% weightage for preparation of finale merit list for admission.</li> </ol>
